

General Mechanic I I Responsibilities

- Must be able use basic hand and power tools with limited instruction and supervision
- Measure accurately in both US and metric systems
- Must be able to read and comprehend blueprints
- Have working knowledge of drill and tap sizes for drilling, using electric, pneumatic or battery hand drills and tools
- Reconcile bill of material against parts kit provided to make sure that everything needed is there before starting job
- Make sure work area is clean and safe at all times
- Interact positively with co-workers, Work Leaders and Supervisors on a daily basis
- Interface with Quality Control and Industrial Engineering to recommend design changes and modifications
- Install sub-components, per direction/instruction and in accordance with blue prints or drawings, and Operations Methods Standards (OPS)
- Any and all other responsibilities, in addition to those mentioned above, as assigned by supervisor/ manager. Any interpretation/clarification with responsibilities above will be settled by the supervisor/ manager. This list of responsibilities is not all inclusive and may change, be added to or deleted from any time
